This letter provides the additional information regarding testing of Limtorque Motor-operators and Preventive Maintenance Program which the NRC requested during the December 7, 1987, SALP Report meeting and that Philadelphia Electric Company (PECo) committed to provide in its SALP response letter dated January 6, 1988.

Testing of Limitorque Motor-Operators

All Limerick Unit 2 Limitorque motor-operators (468 total) are being MOVATS tested. To date, this testing is 80% complete. Much of the MOVATS testing was performed in a shop environment in conjunction with the Limitorque Rework Program which is 95% complete. The hydraulic locking concern is being addressed as part of this rework program. The remaining 20% of Limerick Unit 2 MOVATS testing will be conducted with the motor operators installed in the plant. The Limerick Unit 2 MOVATS testing is scheduled for completion by April 30, 1988.

Preventive Maintenance

In regard to the status of the efforts to assure the proper implementation of the Preventive Maintenance (PM) and equipment storage programs, site personnel have provided the requested information directly to the NRC Resident Inspector.
