On June 22, 1997, ComEd returned Quad Cities Station Unit 2 to service following the unit's fourteenth refuel outage (Q2R14). In the course of that outage, ComEd completed actions related to various NRC commitments. This letter provides a summary of those actions.

The following NRC commitments were completed during this outage:

- Repair of the Unit 2 Reactor Head Flange (Commitment made in an NRC and Station Management meeting).
- b) Removal of the furmanite clamp and repair of the Recirculation Pump leak (Commitment made in ESK Letter 96-197, dated October 30, 1996).
- Inspection of the Unit 2 Core Shroud modification (Commitment made in ESK Letter 96-032, dated March 15, 1996).
- Maintenance on the 2B Residual Heat Removal Heat Exchanger (Commitment made in ESK Letter 96-197, dated October 30, 1996).
- Restoration of the Control Room Emergency Ventilation System Train B to full conformance (Commitment made in ESK Letter 97-058, dated March 21, 1997).
- f) Installation of new design Emergency Core Cooling System Suction Strainers and reduction of fibrous material in the Torus. (Commitment made in response to NRC Bulletin 96-03).

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- Performed inspections of various snubbers throughout the plant (Commitment made in ESK Letter 96-077 dated May 20, 1996).
- h) Completed required testing of Safety Related Contacts (Generic Letter 96-01) for Unit 2. (Commitment made in J. Hosmer letter dated January 28, 1997).
