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Regulatory Guide 1.72, Revision 2, "Spray Pond Piping Made from Fiberglass-Reinforced Thermosetting Resin," describes a method acceptable to the NRC staff for complying with the Commission's regulations with regard to the design, fabrication and testing of fiberglass-reinforced thermosetting resin piping for spray pond applications. This guide has been revised as a result of public comment and additional staff review.

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
