EXCEPTIONS TO REFERRALS

- (1) The need for NRC to take immediate action.
- (2) The information cannot be release in sufficient detail to address the allegation without compromising the identity of a confidential source.
- (3) The licensee could compromise a future investigation/inspection because of knowledge gained from the release of information, especially if wrongdoing is involved.
 - (4) There is a perceived risk that the release of information could bring harm to the alleger.
 - (5) The allegation is made <u>against</u> the licenses, management or <u>those parties who</u> would normally receive and <u>address</u> the allegation.
 - (6) The licensee, applicant or vendor has displayed an inability to "self investigate" the type of information provided.
 - (7) The alleger has voiced <u>persuasive objections</u> over the release of the allegation to the licensee.
 - (8) The allegation is based on <u>intelligence</u> from another governmental agency, which does not approve of the information being released in a referral.
 - (9) The allegation does not warrant follow-up and/or the allegation is frivolous in nature.
