On November 25, 1987, we verbally notified your Mr. R. F. Warnick of a deficiency involving nozzle load stresses (for various nozzles) which may fail to meet FSAR limits. This condition was discovered during seismic equipment qualification review activities and is potentially reportable under the provisions of 10CFR50.55(e).

Further evaluation is required to assess the possible impact of these discrepancies.

Our next report on this issue will be submitted by March 9, 1988.
