NRC Region III recently received an allegation pertaining to inaccurate work history records (trustworthy employee letters) provided to the Illinois Power Company for granting unescorted access to the Clinton Power Station. We request that the Illinois Power Company fully analyze the allegation, initiate an appropriate investigation, and take all actions you deem appropriate. We also request that the results of your review and disposition of this matter be submitted to us within 45 days after receipt of this letter.

The enclosure to this letter should be strictly controlled and distribution limited to personnel only with a "need-to-know" until your investigation of the allegation has been completed and reviewed by NRC Region III.
