Gentlemen:

During the May 3, 1994, status conference, the Licensing Board ruled that on May 13, 1994, the parties would exchange their "best current" witness lists with respect to "phase 2" of this proceeding (i.e., the allegation of false statements concerning diesel starts) and that on the same date Intervenor would provide his first round of notices of deposition. 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
