The review has been completed and there have been no findings that invalidate any of the Region III inspections. As you are aware, prior to licensing, both the licensee and Region III conducted thorough evaluations of the Safeteam to ensure that there were no major safety problems associated with the existing concerns. Additionally, our review indicates that enforcement action is not necessary.

The implementation and effectiveness of the licensees proposed improvements to the safeteam have not been fully evaluated. The resident inspectors are monitoring the licensee actions and will document these findings in routine inspection reports. However, based on the resolution of a recent environmental/seismic qualification concern, we will also evaluate the need for a quarterly update. If you have any further questions contact N. J.
