Proposed Technical Specifications Changes Borated Water Sources (T.S.'s 3.1.2.5/3.1.2.6)

## Gentlemen:

Attached (pursuant to 10CFR 50.4 and 50.90) are proposed license amendments to facility operating licenses NPF-9 and NPF-17 for McGuire Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2, respectively. The proposed amendments revise the minimum contained borated water volume requirements (RE T.S.'s 3.1.2.5/3.1.2.6) of the Boric Acid Storage system to reflect an adjustment to the zero percent level of the Boric Acid Tanks. This correction resulted from a recent re-evaluation of the piping associated with the tanks and transfer pumps. The adjusted values are presently being administratively implemented since they are more conservative than the current technical specifications.

Attachment 1 contains the proposed technical specification changes. Attachment 2 discusses the justification and safety analysis to support the proposed changes. Pursuant to 10CFR 50.91, Attachment 3 provides the analysis performed in accordance with the standards contained in 10CFR 50.92 which concludes that the proposed amendments do not involve a significant hazards consideration, and Duke is forwarding a copy of this amendment request application and no significant hazards consideration analysis to the North Carolina Department of Human Resources. The proposed amendments have been reviewed and have been determined to have no adverse safety or environmental impact.

Pursuant to 100PR 170.3(y), 170.12(a), and 170.21, a check for the Licease Amendment application fee is enclosed in the amount of \$150.00.
