

We sent in the report on Kerr-McGee today and, although it is still quite lengthy (21 pages), we attempted to organize it somewhat differently than had been done in the past. Now that it is completed we see certain areas that might be improved in the future, but we would also like any comments or suggestions that you might have. Some of the things which we tried to do included:

1. Organizing the report along the lines of a normal follow-up inspection report.
2. Drawing together in paragraph six a more concise set of findings.
3. Summarizing the licensee's survey data.
4. Eliminating where possible appendices by quoting or summarizing in the details, correspondence between L&R and the licensee.
5. Restricting the memorandum to an overall summary and our evaluation.
6. Restricting the number of photographs to those of material significance and attaching the photo's to bond paper rather than to the bulky cellophane holders.
7. Limiting the data reported to that necessary to establish compliance or pertinent matters of health and safety.

In addition to your comments on these "mechanical" changes, we would also appreciate, of course, any comments on the substance of the report.
