Gentlemen:

Pursuant to your recent application we have issued and are enclosing Source Material License No. R-157.

As you are probably aware, the Commission published in July, 1955, as a notice of proposed rule making, a proposed regulation establishing standards for protection of personnel and the public against radiation hazards. This proposed regulation is entitled "Standards for Protection Against Radiation." A copy is attached. While this proposed regulation is not presently generally applicable to all licenses it is probable that it will be promulgated, with some modifications, as an effective regulation in the reasonably near future. We expect to distribute shortly an up-to-date draft of these proposed regulations. At that time we will furnish you a copy and solicit your comments, particularly with respect to the applicability of these regulations to your licensed activity.
