
DUCUESNE LIGHT COMPANY, ET AL DOCKET NO. 50-334 MOTICE OF KITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OFERATING LICENSE

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of Duquesne Light Company (the licensee) to mithdraw a portion of its February 10, 1987 application for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License No. DFR-66 for the Reaver Valley Power Station, Unit No. 1, located in Shippingport, Reaver County, Pennsylvania.

Farts of amendment would have revised the setpoints for two radiation monitors (RM-RM-219 and RM-GW-109) as a result of the licensee's proposed reduction in the value of the atmospheric dispersion factor.

The Commission has issued a Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment published in the FEDERAL PEGISTER on April 8, 1987 (52 FR 11362). By letter dated August 27, 1987, the stoff issued Amendment No. 113 to Operating License DPR-66, which granted some of the changes requested by the licensee. By letter dated September 14, 1987, the licensee withdrew the proposed change regarding the above-mentioned radiation monitors.

For further details with respect to this action, see the application for amendment dated February 10, 1987, the staff's letter dated August 27, 1987 and the licersee's letter dated September 14, 1987, withdrawing parts of the
