
Pursuant to the subject generic letter, South Carolina Electric & Gas Company (SCE&G) is submitting the following response under oath of affirmation.

SCE&G established a periodic verification program to ensure that safety-related motor-operated valves (MOVs) continue to be capable of performing their safety functions within the current licensing bases of the facility in response to generic letter 89-10, "Safety-Related Motor-Operated Valve Testing and Surveillance". As requested SCE&G will review our MOV program to determine whether any changes are appropriate based on the subject generic letter.

A written summary description of SCE&G's MOV periodic verification program, including any changes made as a result of the above review, will be submitted to the NRC within the 180 day time period (by March 17, 1997).
