This refers to your letter dated September 11, 1987, in response to our letter dated August 12, 1987.

Thank you for informing us of the actions you have taken with regard to the findings enumerated in the subject inspection report. These actions will be examined during future inspections of your security program.

With respect to your comments concerning the inspector's statement in Paragraph 3 of the inspection report, be assured that it was not our intent to infer that the management of Pennsylvania Power and Light Company is recalcitrant or unresponsive to NRC concerns. The statement was intended to reflect the substance of the explanation you provided in Attachment 2 of your September 11, 1987 letter, but, admittedly, was poorly worded. We apologize for the inference and remain aware of your management philosophy to be responsive to and cooperate with the NRC.

Attachments 1 and 2 of your letter contain Safeguards Information that is exempt from public disclosure under 10 CFR 73.21. Therefore, they will not be placed in the NRC's Public Document Room. This letter and your transmittal letter will be placed in the Public Document Room in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a).
