SUBJECT: LEAK OF SLIGHTLY RADIOACTIVE WATER

The licensee has informed the NRC that on February 11, 1988 at 1:30 p.m. (EST), an approximately 1,000 gallon leak of slightly radioactive water occurred during maintenance on a valve at Oconee Unit 1. The water was contained and will be treated in the waste water system.

Two workers were slightly contaminated by the leak. The affected workers showered to remove the contamination. There were no injuries.

The licensee informed the NRC resident inspector and issued a press release.

Minor local media interest followed. Both the licensee and the NRC are prepared to respond to media inquiries.

The NRC received initial notification of this event when the licensee notified the resident inspector at 1:45 p.m. (EST) on February 11. The licensee later notified the headquarters incident response center.
