By EN 87-102 dated December 7, 1987, the Commission was notified of the intent of OE to issue a Notice of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty in the amount of \$1,000 to Precision Logging and Perforating Company. This action was based on numerous safety violations including (a) failure to complete required surveys, (b) unsecured material, (c) failure to post required documents, (d) unavailable records, (e) missing shipping labels and papers, and

(f) improper storage of licensed material.

The licensee responded to the Notice in two letters dated January 7, 1988. After careful consideration of the licensee's response, the staff has concluded that the violations did occur as set forth in the Notice. However, the penalty has been reduced by 50 percent because of the licensee's inability to pay. Accordingly, an Order Imposing Civil Penalty in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) has been issued today. Under the terms of the Order, the licensee may within 30 days of the date of the Order, pay the civil penalty or request a hearing.
