Attached is a copy of the final exercise report of the October 14, 1987, exercise of the offsite radiological emergency preparedness plans site-specific to the Waterford 3 Steam Electric Station. This final exercise report was prepared by the Region VI office staff of the Federal Emergency Management Agency.

There are no deficiencies identified during this exercise; however, there was one area requiring corrective action which was carried over from the previous exercise in October 1986, and several areas recommended for improvement. Based on the results of the exercise, the offsite radiological emergency plans and preparedness remain adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public in the event of an accident at the Waterford 3 Steam Electric Station and the 44 CFR 350 approval granted on July 15, 1985, remains in effect.
