Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, Commonwealth Edison is hereby applying for an amendment to Facility Operating Licenses NPF-37 and NPF-66, Appendix A, Technical Specifications. The purpose of this amendment is to revise a technical specification action statement concerning the ultimate heat sink. The particular action statement involves Rock River water level and flow. Attachment A contains the proposed change to action requirement 3.7.5.e.(2). Attachment B contains background information regarding the proposed change.

The proposed technical specification change has been reviewed and approved by both On-Site and Off-Site review in accordance with Commonwealth Edison Company procedures.
