instructions, charts, schedules, photos, sketches, maps, records, accounts, machine readable records and computer translations, and reports or notes of consultants.

As used herein, the term "contact" means any type of communication, written or oral.

As used herein, the term "The Commonwealth of Massachusetts" means all state offices, agencies, and departments, including those of the Executive, Civil Defense, and the Attorney General.

If any privilege or work product immunity is claimed as a ground for not producing any document, state for each such document its preparation date(s), author(s), addressee(s), recipient(s), custodian(s), title(s), number of pages, and subject matter to the extent not privileged, as well as the basis for withholding it.

#### REQUEST NO. 1

All documents created since July, 1985, relating to any contact between E. A. Thomas and any official, employee, or representative of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts on any matter relating to nuclear power, emergency planning, and/or Seabrook Station.

#### REQUEST NO. 2

All documents relating to any contact between any official, employee, or representative of FEMA (including E. A. Thomas) and any official, employee, or representative of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts regarding the substance

of FEMA's or E. A. Thomas's testimony in the above-captioned proceeding.

## REQUEST NO. 3

All documents created since July, 1985, regarding any contact between any FEMA official, employee, or representative (including E. A. Thomas) and any official, employee, or representative of The Commonwealth of Massachusetts regarding the views of Regional Assistance Committee members on the issue in the above-captioned matter of shelter for the summer beach population.
