FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST

Throughout the 1960s and early 1970s, the United States Geological Survey (USGS) acted as consultant to the AEC/NRC on geology and seismology reviews for the Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant (Docket Nos. 50-275 and 50-323). In fulfilling this role, a number of meetings were held between the USGS and the AEC/NRC to discuss the geology and seismology of the site.
