"Reply to a notice of Violation"

Gentlemen:

I am confirming and acknowledging the receipt of your letter dated March 28, 1988, in reference to the notice of violation found during the above reference inspection audit performed by Mrs. S. Waldron.

In reference to the violation described in your letter for N.R.C. requirements in accordance with the "General Statement of Policy and Procedure for N.R.C. Enforcement Actions", 10cr Part 2, Appendix C, in my application for material license, Sect. V 5.1; we accept that we incurred in this Level IV violation, as noted by Mrs. S. Waldron.

We incurred in such violation because the person that had to be sent to Gamma Industries for the initial training of one week, does not speak english and he would not be able to understand such training. For this reason he had to take the initial training of one week in our facilities, in accordance to SNT-TC-1A and NRC requirements, but we committed an error for not submitting to the NRC our training program for your approval.

We are requesting an opportunity to submit to the NRC the correction of the initial training program together with the renewal of our license which expires on August 31, 1988, for your approval.
