Gentlemen:


This letter is written in response to your letter dated March 14, 1988, transmitting Notices of Violation and Proposed Imposition of Civil Penalty, Inspection Reports 50-298/87-27, 87-31, and 87-32. Therein you indicated that four of our activities were in violation of NRC requirements, and that one of these was being assessed a civil penalty. Attachment 2 addresses the violation assessed a \$25,000 civil penalty.

The attachments to this letter are responses to the statements of violation in accordance with 10CFR2.201. Some of the material enclosed is Safeguards Information per the provisions of 10CFR Part 73.21, and accordingly the District requests that those attachments be treated as Safeguards Information and withheld from public disclosure.

Mitigation is not being requested pursuant to 10CFR2.205 and payment of the \$25,000 civil penalty is enclosed.
