MEMORANDUM TO FILE

On April 6, 1988 I met with senior managers of Philadelphia Electric Company (PECO) and members of the NRC staff. The following individuals were present:

J. Paquette, Jr., President and Chief Executive Officer, PECO  
C. McNeill, Jr., Executive Vice President - Nuclear, PECO  
V. Stello, Jr., Executive Director for Operations, NRC  
J. Taylor, Acting Deputy Executive Director for Operations, NRC  
J. Murray, Deputy Director, Office of the General Counsel, NRC  
B. Clayton, Regional Coordinator, Office of Deputy Executive Director for Regional Operations, NRC

The meeting was requested by PECO. The purpose of the meeting was to introduce Mr. Paquette who was recently selected as President and Chief Executive Officer. Mr. Paquette and Mr. McNeill stressed that there was a new management team in place at PECO and that the management and the board were determined to restart and operate Peach Bottom safely and to work cooperatively with NRC to attain high quality safety performance. They stated that they anticipated being ready to restart Unit 2 in early November and that the maintenance backlog was the determining factor in the projection. They discussed plans for strengthening the onsite engineering staff, changing the QA/QC organization, and improving maintenance (e.g., better training) over the next couple of years. They are actively working to improve relations with the local communities, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and the State of Maryland.

I told them that when NRC decides that Peach Bottom can be allowed to restart we want to see a flawless startup. I also informed them that we would expect to brief the Commission twice on Peach Bottom - a status briefing about June or July and a second briefing when we and PECO feel that the plant is ready to restart.

No regulatory decisions were requested or made during this meeting.
