On October 7, 1980, a show cause hearing was held before the Environmental Improvement Division of the New Mexico Health and Phvironment Department (EID) to consider whether UNC Mining and Milling's extension of time to submit an approved discharge plan and to operate its Church Rock uranium mill without an approved discharge plan, should be declared null and void.

As a result of the hearing and after reviewing the record in this matter, I make the following determinations:

- 1. On August 8, 1980, pursuant to Section 3-106.A. of the Water Quality Control Commission Regulations, EID granted UNC an extension of time until November 30, 1980, to submit a discharge plan and to continue discharging without an approved plan. That extension of time was requested by UNC by letter dated July 16, 1980. Good cause to grant the extension was shown by UNC at a meeting between UNC staff and consultants and EID staff held August 5, 1980 and in a letter from UNC dated August 5, 1980.
- 2. By letter dated October 3, 1980, EID informed UNC that EID had reason to believe that UNC had violated the conditions of the August 8, 1980 extension. A hearing was scheduled for October 10, 1980 for UNC to show cause why the August 8, 1980 extension should not be declared null and void. The hearing was rescheduled to October 7, 1980 at the request of UNC.
- 3. At the hearing held October 7, 1980, UNC showed good cause why the

extension of time until November 30, 1980 should not be declared null and void; therefore, the extension remains in effect until November 30, 1980.
