These documents include, but are not limited to, utility reports on the incident and its causes; daily operating reports for the plant for the days in question; correspondence between the utlity and the NRC about the incident; any internal NRC reports or documents about the incident, including minutes of any internal NRC meetings at which the incident was discussed; and any reports by outside consultants about the incident.

I am making this request in my capacity as a news reporter for WTOL-TV. I hope to use the requested information for a news story.

If all or any part of this request is denied, please cite the specific exemption(s) which you think justifies your refusal to release the information and inform me of your agency's administrative appeal procedures available to me under the law.
