This in reference to Routine Inspection No. 87-001
conducted November 3-4, 1987.

Your inspectors have concluded that two radiographers
have not been audited every three months. A disparity exists
in pocket dosimeter records with our Isotope Utilization
Log, and failure to record surveys in unrestricted areas.

The attached form will be used each and every time a
radiographic operation is conducted in Boston. This form
will preclude any omissions to license requirements.

Disciplinary letters have been drawn up to issue to
all radiographers involved in failure to record pocket
dosimeter in and out readings. However, letters have not
been issued due to the complete shutdown of all isotope
and x-ray operations by Eastern Airlines in Boston on
February 15, 1988. License material has been placed at
Amersham Tech/Ops, Burlington, Mass. for storage.

I apologize to the N.R.C. for my neglect and look for-
ward to more diligence in the application of my license.

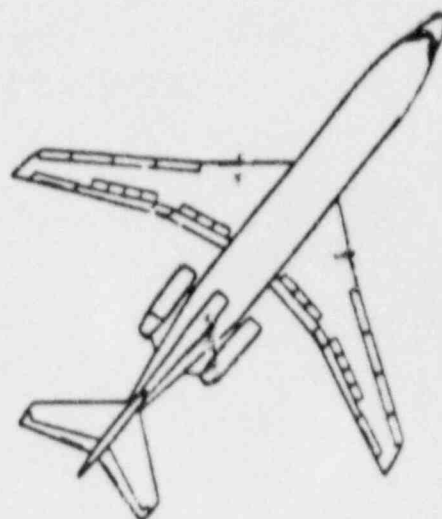
