SUBJECT: Exercise Report for the December 15, 1987, Exercise
of the Offsite Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP)
Plans for the James A. Fitzpatrick Nuclear Power Plant

Attached is a copy of the Post Exercise Assessment (PEA) for the December 15, 1987, full participation joint exercise of the offsite REP plans for the James A. Fitzpatrick Nuclear Power Plant (JAFNPP), the State of New York and Oswego County. The PEA, dated June 3, 1988, was prepared by Region II of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and transmitted to FEMA Headquarters on June 22, 1988.

There were no offsite deficiencies identified during the JAFNPP exercise. The New York State Emergency Management Office has been requested to provide FEMA Region II with a statement of actions taken, or a schedule of corrective actions to be taken, to correct the exercise inadequacies identified as areas requiring corrective action.

Based on the results of the exercise, FEMA considers that offsite radiological emergency preparedness is adequate to provide reasonable assurance that appropriate measures can be taken offsite to protect the health and safety of the public living in the vicinity of the site in the event of a radiological emergency. Therefore, the approval under FEMA Rule 44 CFR 350 will remain in effect.
