This letter contains a proposed amendment to the Technical Specifications for Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-35 and NPF-52 for Catawba Units 1 and 2 and NPF-9 and NPF-17 for McGuire Units 1 and 2. The request involves deleting the requirement to provide a complete listing of all individual results of all radiological environmental samples and all environmental radiation measurements as required by Technical Specification 6.9.1.6. The results will still be provided in a summarized and tabulated format as required.

The attachment contains the proposed change and a discussion of the justification and a No Significant Hazards analysis. The analysis is included pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91 and it has been concluded that the proposed amendment does not involve significant hazards considerations.
