



Thank you for your letter dated April 12, 1038, informing us of the steps you have taken to correct the violations identified in our letter dated March 9, 1988. While your letter states that you will file an application for an appropriate amendment, it should be understood that no activity is in accord with NRC regulatory requirements unless and until it is specifically authorized in an NRC license. Steps should be taken to ensure that NRC-licensed materials are hereafter possessed and used only as authorized by your license. We will examine this matter during a future inspection.
