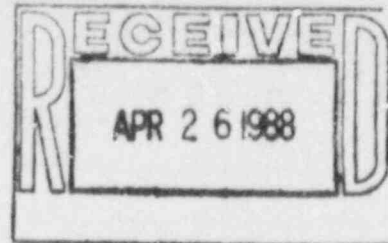


Dear Mr. Everett:

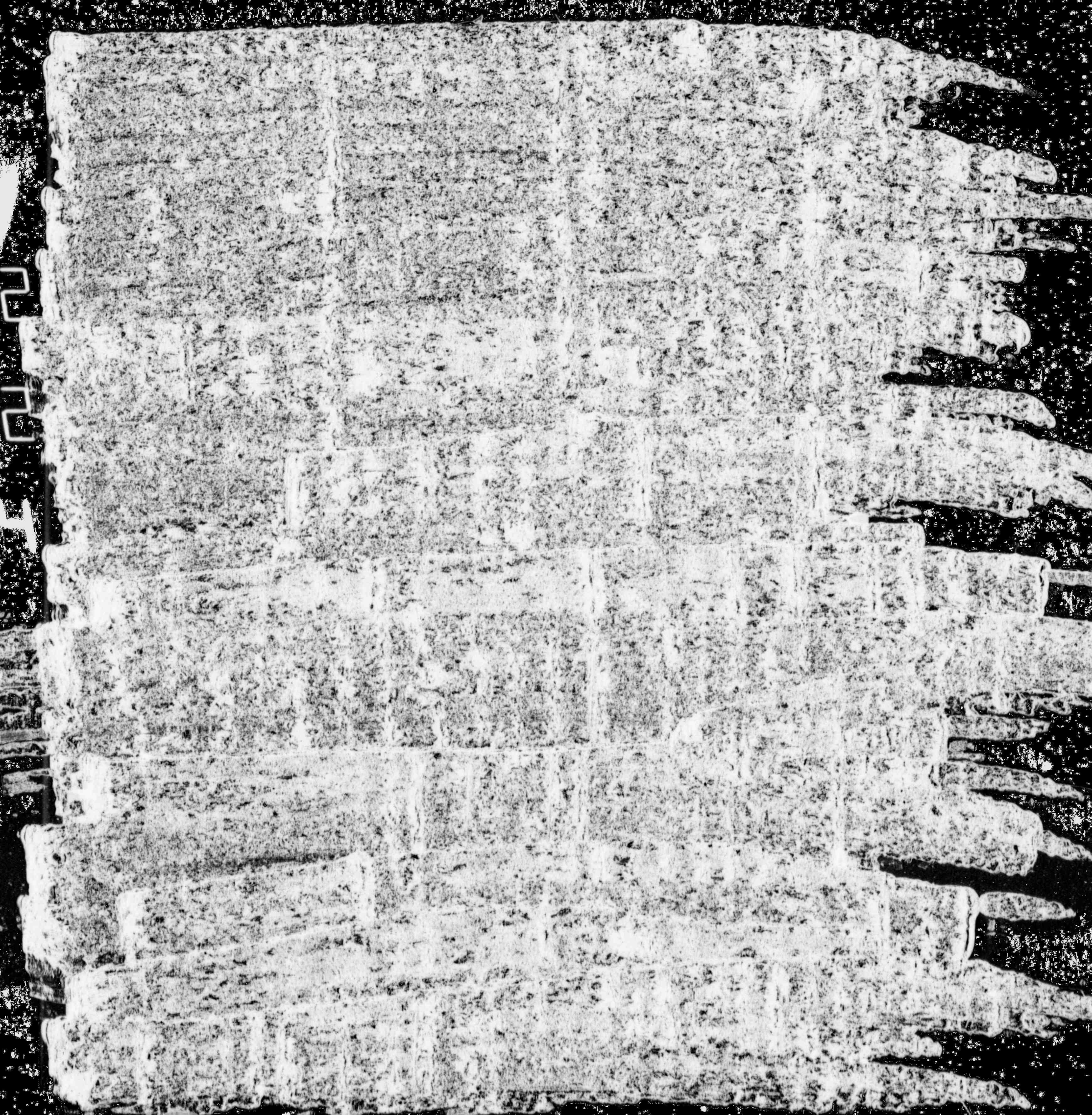


