This Board is being established pursuant to a notice published by the Commission on August 11, 1998, in the Federal Register (63 Fed. The proceeding involves an application by Duke Energy Corporation to

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renew operating licenses for Units 1, 2 and 3 of its Oconee Nuclear Station pursuant to the provisions of 10 C.F.R. Part 54. The renewal license, if granted, would authorize the applicant to operate those units for an additional 20-year period.



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
