Gentlemen:

This refers to Materials License 37-20963-02G, which was issued February 26, 1988. The license was issued in accordance with your November 10, 1987 application.

Through an oversight, the license was issued without the required fee being collected. At the time your November 10, 1987 application was filed, it appeared that your request would be subject to fee Category 3P of \$170.31 of the enclosed 10 CFR 170, and an application fee of \$230 was paid. However, since the license was issued to authorize distribution of in vitro kits to general licensees, an application fee of \$290 is required for your November 10, 1987 application as specified in fee Category 3K of \$170.31. Accordingly, an additional fee of \$60 is required (\$290 due minus \$230 paid). Payment of the additional \$60 should be made to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and sent to the attention of Sandra Kimberley at our Washington, D.C. address.

We apologize for the delay in notifying you of the additional fee due and for any inconvenience this matter may cause you.
