The licensee declared Unit 1 entered commercial operation on 02/13/86, following the completion of the power ascension test program and 100 hours of continuous run above 95% power as committed to the Arizona Corporation Commission.

Palo Verde Unit 1 was granted an operating license on December 31, 1984, and a full power license was granted on June 1, 1985.
