Louisiana Power & Light hereby files an application for two amendments to the Waterford 3 Technical Specifications:

- NPF-38-13 involves a one time only extension of the containment leakage Type B and C testing to the first refueling outage.
- NPF-38-14 clarifies the allowable surveillance interval for diesel generator inspection.

Until recently LP&L had tentatively planned an outage for the month of March, 1986 in order to perform the local leak rate testing (LLRT) under Surveillance Requirements 4.6.1.2.d/f and the diesel generator inspection under Surveillance Requirement 4.8.1.1.2.d.1. Under the present Technical Specifications the LLRT is due in March, 1986 while a conservative interpretation of the diesel generator inspection requirement places it due in June, 1986. Absent these surveillance requirements LP&L would not shutdown Waterford 3 for an extended outage.

While LP&L was aware of the potential for shutdown some time ago, a request for Technical Specification changes was not possible without assessing the status of the diesel generators and containment integrity close to the proposed outage time. An earlier Technical Specification change request would have been based on supposition. George W. Knighton W3P86-0033 Page 2

As noted in the attached submittals recent diagnostic data on the diesel generators is now available as well as current containment leakage values. Based on this, and other information, the requested changes to the Technical Specifications do not pose a significant hazards consideration nor do they involve an unreviewed safety question.

Should these changes not be granted in a timely manner LP&L will be forced to implement a month-long outage with concomitant large expense to the company and its ratepayers. Therefore, LP&L requests that the proposed changes be reviewed as emergency requests in accordance with 10 CFR 50.91.
