AMENDMENT REULEST DATED JULY 13, 1988

I telephone CPT Carter to discuss his July 13, 1988 letter requesting, among other things, that certain sources manufactured by Amersham Corporation and Isotope Froducts Laboratories, Inc. be added to the Fort Sam Houston license.

I indicated to DPT Carter that I thought it would be better if we raised the authorized limits currently specified on the license to cover the requested increases in americium-241 and cesium-137 sources, as well as expanded the current authorization to cover additional sealed sources. He agreed with me that this would allow them greater flexibility in their training programs.

Instead of listing the individual sources I am going to raise the limits specified on the license to cover the requested 110 millicurie limits. No single source to exceed 110 millicuries for 3-83 materials and americium.
