Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. C. A. Hackney of this office during the period March 21-25, 1988, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License NPF-38 for the Waterford 3 Steam Electric Station and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. R. Barkhurst and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included: emergency facilities, equipment, instrumentation, supplies, organization and management control, and independent reviews/audits.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Normally, you are required to respond to violations, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response during the inspection, which included an admission of the alleged violation, an explanation of the causes, corrective steps which have been taken with the immediate results, and the outlined corrective steps which have been taken to avoid further violations, was based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter. Therefore, no written response to this violation is required.

Should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we will be pleased to discuss them with you.
