Dear Mr. Pelchat:

In conjunction with our incident report filed on July 28, 1987 and our September 3, 1987 enforcement conference, this letter is to update our listed corrective action.

Item #6 has been completed, in that a new Entry Permit with a separate block for Nuclear Gauge Lockout has been developed. As outlined at the enforcement conference, the Entry Permit is a safety basic in the refinery.

The permit (attached) is presently being reviewed as part of our annual operator safety awareness training and will be instituted on December 1, 1987.

Item #3 - a Radiation Safety Course to be conducted by Ohmart Corporation has been scheduled for November 17-18-19 for appropriate refinery personnel. After completion of this training, a license amendment request will be filed to update personnel supervising radioactive material.

The subject gauges have been packaged and disposal authorization received from the Ohmart Corporation. The gauges will be returned to Ohmart within the next two weeks.
