
This letter contains proposed amendments to the Technical Specifications for Facility Operating License Nos. NPF-35 and NPF-52 for Catawba Units 1 and 2 and Nos. NPF-9 and NPF-17 for McGuire Units 1 and 2. The attachments contain the proposed changes and a discussion of the justification and safety analysis. The analysis is included pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91 and it has been concluded that the proposed amendments do not involve significant hazards considerations.

The proposed amendments would involve changing Technical Specification 3.3.3.6 and Tables 3.3-10 and 4.3-7 "Accident Monitoring Instrumentation" to reflect the Regulatory Guide 1.97 reviews which have been done for both stations. The changes would involve having the Tables contain only those instruments which have been determined to be Type A Variables as defined in the Regulatory Guide and relocating those instruments which are not Type A variables to the applicable FSAR.

This proposal constitutes an amendment request on Catawba's and McGuire's Technical Specifications. Accordingly, pursuant to 10 CFR 170.21 a check for \$150.00 is enclosed.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91 (b) (1) the appropriate South Carolina and North Carolina State Officials are being provided a copy of this amendment request.


