In TVA's August 17, 1988 submittal to NRC concerning the need for an additional assistant shift operations supervisor. TVA committed to revise Emergency Instructions ES-0.2. "SI Termination," and E-1, "Loss of Reactor or Secondary Coolant." Upon further evaluation, it has been determined that a revision to ES-0.2 is not required to ensure performance of the compensatory measure (CM) to start the main control room heating, ventilating, and air conditioning. The revision to E-1, coupled with the existing procedural steps in ES-0.2, will ensure the CM is performed in a timely manner and will not affect the performance of safety-related equipment. Therefore, TVA will not revise ES-0.2 as committed to in the August 17, 1988 submittal. That commitment is hereby deleted.
