On 06 May 1988, I received a call from Theresa Darden of the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (USNRC). She was inquiring about the status of WESTON/ARCO action items per our 07 October 1987 meeting and subsequently outlined on my 11 December 1987 correspondence to you. The purpose of this letter is to address the status of the following five (5) action items listed in the aforementioned correspondence:

- o Reconstitute pacemaker hotline number.
- o Reissue Medic Alert bracelets and wallet cards to wearers.
- o Submit a report required by condition 12 of ARCO's license.
- o Submit a request to modify condition 12 of the license.
- o Include Mr. John Kenneman on future submissions of the semi-annual pacemaker inventory report.

Reconstitute Pacemaker Hotline Telephone Number

The pacemaker hotline number was reinstated on 15 December 1987. Since then, Weston has received an average of about one (1) call every other week regarding pacemaker information.
