Conference Schedule)



ORDERED, that the Licensing Board will hold a prehearing conference in this proceeding beginning on Thursday, November 12, 1998, at 9:30 a.m. in the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board Panel Hearing Room, Room T-3B45, Third Floor, Two White Flint North Building, 11545 Rockville Pike, Rockville, Maryland. Although the prehearing conference will continue until completed, the Board anticipates it should take no more than two days.

At the prehearing conference, the Board will entertain arguments on (1) the issue of standing, based on the information in petitioner National Whistleblower Center's (NWC) August 7, 1998 hearing request/intervention petition and any additional information NWC supplies in conjunction with its petition supplement, now scheduled to be filed on or before October 1, 1998; and (2) the admissibility of any NWC contentions proffered in its petition supplement.


