

SUBJECT: ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS TAKEN ON OI CASES

The purpose of this Enforcement Guidance Memorandum is to remind the staff that correspondence with licensees concerning enforcement action or lack of enforcement action as a result of an OI investigation requires review and concurrence by the Office of Enforcement (OE).

In accordance with Commission direction, where the staff disagrees with conclusions in an OI report on wrongdoing issues, such as willfulness, the matter is to be referred to the Commission (Memorandum dated March 18, 1986 from Chilk to Stello). If a region disagrees with the conclusions of OI, please promptly discuss it with OE. A decision can then be made and a draft Commission paper prepared, if the staff position is to differ with OI.
