This report addresses the results of all startup testing identified in the Beaver Valley Power Station Unit No. 2 Final Safety Analysis Report during the period from declaration of Commercial Operations to February 15, 1988. Completion of the startup test program has not been fully accomplished due to some deferred testing. A supplemental report will be issued within 90 days to update the progress of the startup test program.
