On May 23, 1988 the Hazardous Communications Act, 29CFR1910.1200, went into effect. To insure compliance with this law, Union Electric has required all currently badged Callaway Plant personnel to receive this training; and have included the information in the initial Orientation Course for all employees prior to initial badging. This material has been included in the Abbreviated Site Access Training Program (Unafettered Access Program), thereby extending the training and badging process from one to two hours.
