Please accept this letter as my reply to a notice of violation in compliance with 10 CFR 2.201. Throughout this proceeding, both in my conference with PECo Security Personnel and with NRC Investigators, I had admitted that during the 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. shift I was, at times, inattentive to instrumentations and controls and that I allowed myself and those under my supervision to be distracted by activities such as reading nonjob related materials while on duty, reclining in a resting position with eyes closed and other activities that precluded adequate performance of licensed duties. During chose conferences, however, interviewing personnel referred to numerous alleged occurrences. I do not admit to the accuracy of each and every alleged occurrence mentioned ir "hose conferences. I will continue to stand by the accuracy of those state ... is that I made during those conferences. During those conferences, I also stated what I beligve to be the reasons for the violations. Those reasons include the general nature of shift work, the manner in which shift work is scheduled, the monotony of routine job verformance, the attitudes of high level administrators, the unavailability of adequate personnel during the midnight shift to permit employees to have sufficient breaks during that shift in order to remain fresh and alert and the lack of options available to supervisors in order to discipline employees.

With regard to the other matters required in this reply by Section 2.201(a)(1)(2) and (3), as I have retired from my employment, I do not feel as though I am in a position to accurately supply such information.

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If further information is required, please so advise. As in the past, it is my intention to cooperate fully in order that all problems associated with this matter can be remedied.
