SUBJECT: BEAVER VALLEY UNIT 1 - RELIEF FROM CERTAIN EXAMINATION
REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PRESSURIZER SURGE LINE (TAC 66640)

By letter dated November 10, 1987, you requested relief, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55a(g)(5)(iii), from certain ASME Section XI inspection requirements for the pressurizer surge line, among other issues. We have reviewed your submittal and recorded our review results in the enclosed safety evaluation. The relief you requested is hereby granted. The relief regarding non-regenerative heat exchanger CH-E-2 has been granted on April 25, 1988, and the request for relief for the steam generator nozzles has been withdrawn by your staff.

We have determined that the inspection requirements are impractical for the items for which relief is being granted and, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.55 a(g)(6)(i), that the granting of relief is authorized by law, will not endanger life or property or the common defense and security, and is otherwise in the public interest. In making this determination, we have given due consideration to the burden that could result if those requirements are imposed on your facility.

This completes all our efforts on your November 10, 1987 submittal. Please feel free to contact your Project Manager, Mr. P. Tam, if you need any clarification.
