The plant was operated safely during the period. Operators performed routine activities including the plant start-up and power ascension well. Maintenance technicians performed several activities well, and engineering provided good support of the spent fuel pool rack modification. The security program was inspected during this period. The NRC determined that you are implementing a security program that protects against acts of radiological sabotage. Also, a radiation protection program inspection took place. Overall, the NRC found the radiation protection program was effectively implemented.
