This is to advise your office of the status of OI's response to reference memorandum.

The alleged requesting confidentiality was telephonically contacted by OI:RII on March 25, 1985. The alleged desired to contact his/her attorney prior to being interviewed.

On March 29, 1985, Attorney Robert Guild of 2135 1/2 Devine Street, Columbia, South Carolina 29205, was telephonically contacted by OI in response to his call on March 28, 1985. Mr. Guild announced that he was representing the confidential alleged and wanted to coordinate with him/her and prepare a sworn affidavit prior to his/her being interviewed by OI.

On April 16, 1985, Robert Guild called and stated that he had not yet gotten with his client (Confidential Alleged) to prepare an affidavit. He stated that he would now like to go ahead and schedule an interview. He stated that he did not think his client could be ready by April 18. The interview is tentatively scheduled for April 30 and/or May 5, 1985.

The other alleged identified in referenced memorandum will be interviewed in Wilmington, NC on April 19, 1985.
