Reference: NRC Region 1 letter, dated April 15, 1988, from Ronald R. Bellamy, Chief Facilities Radiological Safety and Safeguards

Gentlemen:

This is in response to the referenced letter in which exceptions were taken by Region 1 to changes made in the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station Contingency Plan, Revision 3, Section 3.3.6, page 27, and portions of the Responsibility Matrix, pages 30-74.

The deletion of Section 3.3.6, page 27, was not considered a decrease in the effectiveness of the plan. In accordance with our Security Plan, a vehicle is available to the security force as required. Since there are no longer remote areas, nor any unimproved terrain within the protected area which would necessitate the use of a vehicle, the assigned vehicle is used primarily in the OCA.

An appropriate revision to the SNPS Contingency Plan, Section 3.3.6, page 27, has been made to include this requirement and is submitted as an attachment to this letter. Also attached are revised pages of the Responsibility Matrix from which all references to two levels of "Licensee Security Supervisors" have been deleted.

The enclosure to this letter contains Safeguards Information and is to be protected in accordance with 10 CFR 73.21.
