Subject: McGuire Nuclear Station Docket Nos. 50-369 and 50-370 Proposed Technical Specifications Changes Delta-T Incident Tech. Spec. Problem Areas (T.S. Table 2.2-1/4.2.3.5/Table 4.3-1/Table 3.3-1)

Gentlemen:

Attached (pursuant to 10CFR 50.4 and 50.90) are proposed license amendments to facility operating licenses NPF-9 and NPF-17 for McGuire Nuclear Station Units 1 and 2, respectively. The proposed amendments correct several technical specification problem areas identified as a result of the evaluation of a gradual decrease in indicated Delta-T incident at McGuire Unit 2, and correct an unrelated action statement wording error. These items are clarifications of intent and do not involve relaxation of existing requirements. These revisions are being requested in order to avoid future interpretation problems (other Delta-T incident problem areas are being addressed by previous submittals or administratively within Duke Power). Note that Duke has been administratively implementing the proposed requirements of the revisions to T.S. 4.2.3.5 and Table 4.3-1 since the McGuire incident.

Attachment 1 contains the proposed technical specification changes. Attachment 2 contains the justification and safety analysis to support the proposed changes. Included in Attachment 2 (Attachment 2A) is the Licensee Event Report discussing the subject Delta-T incident. Pursuant to 10CFR 50.91, Attachment 3 provides the analysis performed in accordance with the standards contained in 10CFR 50.92 which concludes that the proposed amendments do not involve a significant hazards consideration, and Duke is forwarding a copy of this amendment request application and no significant hazards consideration analysis to the North Carolina Department of Human Resources. The proposed amendments have been reviewed and have been determined to have no adverse safety or environmental impact.

Pursuant to 10CFR 170.3(y), 170.12(c), and 170.21, enclosed (check) is the license amendment application fee of \$150.00.

Note that the subject Delta-T incident was discussed in NRC/OIE Inspection Report A001 Nos. 50-369/85-24 and 50-370/85-25 (ref. Inspector Followup Item 370/85-25-01), and 50-369/85-40 and 50-370/85-41 (ref. Unresolved Item 370/85-41-01 which remains open to date), and 50-369/87-27 and 50-370/87-27.
